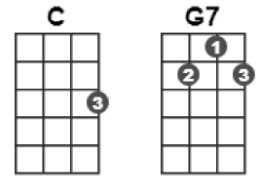

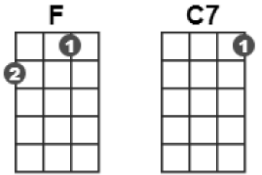

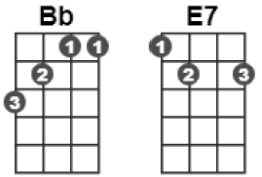

**G7 C G7**



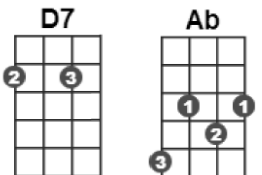
**Track twenty nine, boy you can give me a shine**
