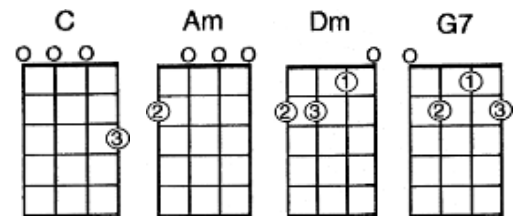


COCKLES AND MUSSELS(MOLLY MALONE)
