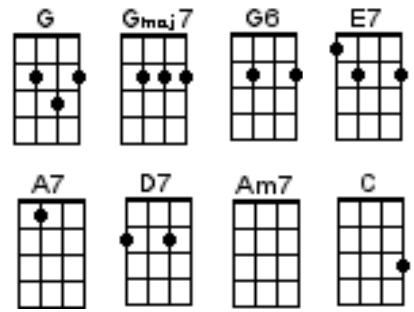


WHY DON'T WOMEN LIKE ME? (George Formby)
