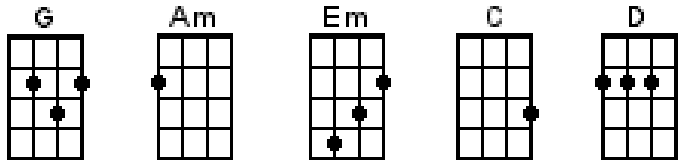


FAREWELL TO WHISKY

Chord accompaniment: gentle strums or 'inside-outside' picking (3-2-4-1-3-2-4-1...)

Chord accompaniment notation for the fiddle tune "Farewell to Whisky". The notation is presented in four systems, each with a treble (T) and bass (B) staff. Chord names (G, Am, Em, C, D) are placed above the corresponding measures. Fingering numbers (0-4) are written below the notes. The piece includes first and second endings, indicated by brackets and the numbers 1. and 2. respectively.
