Intro/Interlude:

C G Am F C G C

Am F
I'm a canny guan man
C G C G
And a roving young fellow I've been

Strumming pattern:

1	&	2	&	3	&	1	&	2	&	3	&
↓		↓	↑	↓	↑	↓		↓	↑	↓	↑

First beat strum on G string, 2 & 3 beat strum on all strings. Upstrokes optional.

CHORUS:

C G
So be easy and free
Am F
When you're drinking wi' me
C G C G
I'm a man you don't meet every day
C G
It's oft I have sat
Am F
With both bottle and friends
C G C G
Is there ae man could e'er ask for more?

Picking pattern:

T = thumb, F = Finger

Picking with the finger in the first beat of the bar is optional

CHORUS

C G
Let us catch well the hours
Am F
And the minutes that fly
C G C G
Let us share them sae well while we may

CHORUS

C G
Come fill up your glass
Am F
With whiskey or wine
C G C G
