

INSTRUCTIONS:

- The TAB above is played with repeats when played as a tune on its own.
- When played with the song (optionally after each chorus), there are no repeats.
- If you wish to play the melody behind the lyrics, the length of the second line extends as the verses add on like this:
 V1: Omit Bar 5
 V2: play as written
 V2: Repeat Bar 5 once
 V4: Repeat Bar 5 twice
 V5: Repeat Bar 5 three times, etc....
